"18 VAC 25-21-260. EXEMPTIONS AND WAIVERS.

Pursuant to § 54.1-603.1 B of the *Code of Virginia*, as amended, the board may grant exemptions or waive or reduce the number of continuing education hours required in cases of certified illness..."

To be provided by a medical doctor:

The medical doctor must certify on a prescription form a detailed explanation of the specific medical illness or condition that prevents the licensee from complying with the Virginia Auctioneers Board requirement of 6 hours of continuing education. In addition, the medical doctor must provide the length of time the licensee will be unable to comply with the regulations due to his/her illness.
