The properly signed form should be submitted with the **Ear-Piercer License and Examination Application** to the exam vendor listed above.

Completion of the apprenticeship program shall qualify the apprentice to apply the Board to take the Board for Barbers and Cosmetology ear piercer license examination.

Curriculum requirements specified in 18VAC 41-60-165 of the *Virginia Board for Barbers and Cosmetology Body-Piercing Regulations* shall be taught over a minimum of 500 hours broken down into the following categories:
